

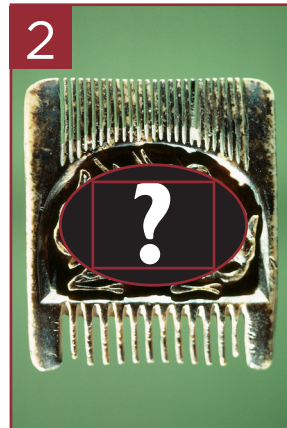
# Jedburgh Abbey

Climb up the steps to reach the gallery and look down the nave. How many steps are there?

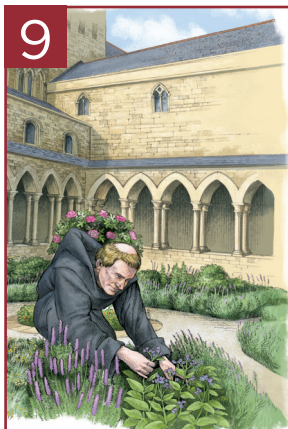




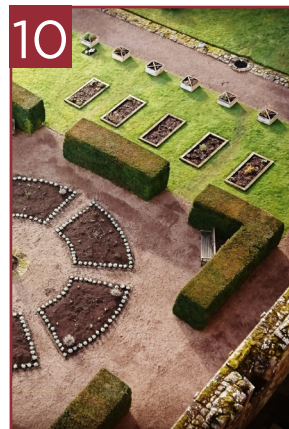
